## **Current Operations**

- Saturday Farmers Market, operational year round
- Thursday Farmers Market, operational May-November
- Sunday Flea Market, operational year round
- Community Garage Sale, operational May-October
- Host and provide space for private & community events
- Facilitate Debit/Credit token sales to increase customer purchasing power
- Distribution EBT, Fresh Connect Coupons, and Senior Nutrition Coupons to boost food access to locally food insecure individuals
